A workshop was organized for the production of coarse grains on 31st May 2025 in Chamba block of Tehri Garhwal under the research project conducted under the Chief Minister Higher Education Research Promotion Scheme at Government College Nainbag. In which farmers of village Chopdiyal and Gunogi of Chamba block were present in the workshop. Along with village head Vinod Dobariyal and Dr. Deveshwaranand, the principal investigator of the research project, Dr. Madhu Bala Juwantha and co-investigator Parmanand Chauhan organized a program to create awareness among the people about coarse grains under the research project project. While addressing the farmers, Dr. Madhu Bala Juwantha said that coarse grains are rich in nutrients which keep away from physical and mental diseases. At present, the demand for coarse grains is increasing rapidly not only in the country but also abroad and it is being used in food. Many types of items like biscuits etc. are also being prepared from coarse grains. Parmanand Chauhan told the farmers that if we want to stay healthy in the present times, we will have to move towards coarse grains. Many types of diseases are troubling people due to the change in food habits in modern life, so we will have to return to the old farming system, only then we will be able to secure our future. Farmers said that they mainly grow Kodo and Jhangora crops, but due to lack of irrigation facilities, there is a problem in its cultivation and the yield is less. If irrigation facilities are provided, the production of coarse grains will increase.


Farmers told that the second main problem in the cultivation of coarse grains is the damage caused by wild animals, monkeys and stray animals. The cultivation of coarse grains is severely damaged by these animals and this problem is faced by the farmers of all the villages. Farmers said that they are interested in the production of coarse grain crops, this not only fulfills their food requirement but also becomes a source of income. Farmers, Gram Pradhans and women from various villages were present in the program.
